From the coverage in the media most members of the public would have no idea of the significance of the event and why it was being held on April 28th.

Rachelle had attended a facebook live event with members from ASDA. It had been well attended and it was felt that ASDA had been slow off the mark in dealing with the pandemic but was picking up pace now.

The secretary had sent a letter to all new members. This is a lot easier now that Marzena Sec is back at work in regional office and is supplying the branch with monthly updates.
